Sherburn Aero Club Aircraft Refuelling Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions ("Terms") govern the refuelling of aircraft at Sherburn Aero Club ("the Club"). By refuelling your aircraft at the Club, you agree to comply with these Terms. Please read them carefully.

1. Fuel Types and Availability

- 1.1. Sherburn Aero Club offers the following types of aviation fuel for sale:
 - 100LL Avgas
 - UL91 Avgas
 - Jet A1
- 1.2. The availability of specific fuel types may vary and is subject to change. The Club will make reasonable efforts to maintain a stock of these fuels but does not always guarantee their availability.

2. Fuel Purchase and Payment

- 2.1. Prior to refuelling, aircraft owners and operators must provide valid payment information and may be required to establish an account with the Club.
- 2.2. Payment for fuel can be made through the following methods: a. **Assisted Refuelling**: Club staff will assist you with the refuelling process, and payment can be made by cash, credit card, or other agreed-upon methods.
- b. **Self-Serve Refuelling**: For your convenience, self-serve refuelling is available using credit card payment at designated fuel dispensers. Please follow posted instructions for self-serve refuelling.
- 2.3. The Club accepts payment by cash, credit card, or other agreed-upon methods for assisted refuelling. For self-serve refuelling, payment is limited to credit card transactions.

3. Fuel Dispensing and Handling

- 3.1. Aircraft owners and operators are responsible for ensuring that their aircraft are properly positioned and secured during refuelling.
- 3.2. Only authorized Club personnel may operate fuel dispensing equipment for assisted refuelling. For self-serve refuelling, customers are responsible for following posted instructions and using the equipment properly.
- 3.3. Aircraft owners and operators are responsible for ensuring that the correct fuel type is dispensed into their aircraft. The Club is not responsible for damage or engine problems resulting from the use of the wrong fuel.
- 3.4. Aircraft must comply with all safety regulations and standards while refuelling. Smoking and open flames are strictly prohibited in the refuelling area.
- 3.5. Any spills or fuel leaks must be reported immediately to Club staff or, in the case of self-serve refuelling, to the designated contact for assistance.

4. Safety and Compliance

- 4.1. Aircraft owners and operators must adhere to all relevant aviation regulations and guidelines when refuelling at the Club, whether using assisted or self-serve refuelling options. Failure to do so may result in the suspension of refuelling privileges.
- 4.2. The Club reserves the right to refuse refuelling services to any aircraft or individual deemed to be in violation of safety regulations or engaged in any unlawful activity.

5. Liability and Insurance

- 5.1. Aircraft owners and operators are responsible for their aircraft and any damage that may occur during the refuelling process.
- 5.2. The Club maintains insurance coverage as required by law, but aircraft owners and operators are encouraged to carry their own insurance to cover any potential damages or liabilities.

6. Termination of Service

6.1. The Club reserves the right to terminate or suspend refuelling services to any aircraft or individual for any reason, including non-payment, safety concerns, or violation of these Terms.

7. Privacy

7.1. The Club may collect and store personal information necessary for fuel transactions and account management. The Club will handle this information in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

8. Changes to Terms and Conditions

8.1. The Club reserves the right to modify these Terms at any time. Updated Terms will be made available to all customers.

By refuelling your aircraft at Sherburn Aero Club, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms and Conditions, including the option for self-serve refuelling using credit card payment. Failure to comply with these Terms may result in the suspension of refuelling privileges and other appropriate actions as deemed necessary by the Club.
